



Need credits this summer? Register for the Mississippi Education & Technology Innovation Symposium to be held June 21-23, 2017. You will get the most benefit by attending the symposium on Day 1 and Day 2. For example, if you attend the conference all day on Day 1 and Day 2 you could earn up to 14 hours. The Opening/General Sessions and Lunch on Day 1 and 2 are included; you would have to attend each of these and five sessions on Day 1 and Day 2 to get 14 hours. You may also earn additional hours for sessions you attend on Day 3.

Make sure your badge is scanned upon entry and exit of EACH session you attend. At the end of each day, you can go to the Registration Desk and give your SSN or Educator ID. Again, you must have your badge scanned upon entry and exit of EACH session at that time.

#### **SEMI Credits:**

For SEMI credits, you must have a minimum of 6 hours to earn 5 SEMI credits. To earn 10 SEMI credits, you must have at least 12 hours. **Also, for the SEMI credits, we must collect your social security number or educator ID number before you leave the event.**

#### **CEU Credits:**

Please follow the chart below for CEU credits.

<b>Number of Hours</b>	<b>Number of CEU Credits</b>
5-9 Hours	.5 - .9 CEU
10 Hours	1 CEU
15 Hours	1.5 CEUs
20 Hours	2 CEUs
