





"Hurry Mittens! Let's go inside," I shouted.


I ran back into the house to find Mom. There was no time to waste. Mom would know just how to help the baby bird. I rushed through the house searching for her. Mittens followed me

When I looked down, there was Mittens. She was looking up at me. I patted Mittens softly on the head and said, "You are the best cat in the whole world. I will always take care of you!"


