This document highlights the allowable read-aloud accommodations for the Grade 3 Mississippi Academic Assessment Program (MAAP) reading portion and the MAAP 3rd Grade Reading Alternative Assessments. All students in grade 3, except those requiring a paper/pencil version per their IEP, 504, or LSP, must complete the writing portion of the ELA MAAP assessment online.
