

## Mississippi Academic Assessment Program (MAAP) Scratch Paper Policy

## General

- Schools must provide scratch paper for students.
- Scratch paper should be handed out as needed, not in stacks. There is
  no minimum or maximum amount of scratch paper per student.
- Scratch paper must be returned to the STC/DTC along with any other testing materials.
- Scratch paper must be stored by the STC for students with Accommodation 25 until the completion of their assessment.
- Districts must shred scratch paper upon completion of the the test.
  - All scratch paper, including graph paper on the Mathematics and
- Science assessments, must be shredded at the district level.
- The DTC must complete and upload the *Test Security Certification Form* from SharePoint within **5 days** of the end of the testing window acknowledging that the scratch paper has been shredded.
