RE:

Maintenance of Effort Requirements (MOE) Met for Fiscal Year 2018

In order for your district to receive Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) funds, the Office of Special Education is required to obtain data to verify that MOE requirements were met by your district annually. Effort must be maintained for the school year 2015-2016 (FY 16) at or above the level of expenditures of the preceding school year 2014-2015 (FY 15) to be eligible for funding in the Fiscal Year 2018. According to the final regulations of the 2004 Amendments to IDEA, a combination of State and local funds may be used to demonstrate maintenance of effort for school districts. These amounts are calculated by utilizing the Financial Electronic Transmission System (FETS) data that your finance office transmits to us at the end of each school/fiscal year. The calculation from your FETS data is a combination of the following:
