Introduction

Chronic absenteeism is defined as missing 10 percent (18 days) of the school year for any reason. Prior to the 2013-2014 school year, Mississippi, like many other states, focused on truancy. Since the early 1980s, truancy and average daily attendance (ADA) was the state's primary focus. Chronic absence differs from ADA, which is the average number of enrolled students who attend school each day. A school's ADA does not reveal how many students are chronically absent. A school can have an ADA of 95 percent or higher while having a chronic absence rate greater than 10 percent.


Mississippi's chronic absenteeism rate is comparable to national rate trends. Our chronic absenteeism rate is high in kindergarten (16.70%), tapers off in early elementary school, and then increases steadily throughout middle and high schools. The rate peaks in Grade 12 at 34.52 percent. In Mississippi, during the 2017-2018 school year, 82,972 students were chronically absent. This represents 16.86 percent of all students in Mississippi public schools, and the rates are significantly higher in many school districts and schools across the state.

The Mississippi Department of Education Mississippi launched a statewide attendance awareness campaign in September of 2018 to promote regular school attendance. The *Strive for Less than Five* campaign challenges students to have no more than five absences over the course of the entire school year. Mississippi's campaign is part of a national movement to reduce chronic absenteeism. Students who miss an average of two school days per month due to excused or unexcused absences or suspensions are considered chronically absent.

"The research is clear about the negative effect that chronic absenteeism has on student achievement," said Dr. Carey Wright, state superintendent of education. "If children are not in school, they are not learning. Starting as early as preschool and kindergarten, chronic absence can leave 3rd graders unable to read proficiently, 6th graders struggling with coursework and high school students off track for graduation." Attendance patterns exhibited early in the school year often predict what will occur later in the year. Researchers at Mississippi KIDS COUNT examined the effect of having excessive absences in the month of September. They found that Mississippi students who had missed between two and four days in September were five times more likely to be chronically absent for the year than students who had missed less than two days. The KIDS COUNT study backs up the findings of other national studies. "School leaders need to examine their data to identify the students who are struggling the most with maintaining regular attendance," Wright said. "We encourage schools to partner with parents and communities to ensure that all students are in school every day learning."

Understanding Chronic Absenteeism

Chronic absenteeism is typically defined as missing 10 percent or more of a school year-approximately 18 days a year, or just two days every month.




Chronic Absenteeism Calculation


- > Any student enrolled in a school for at least 10 days must be included in the calculation.
- > Any student absent 10% or more of the time that he/she was enrolled in any school.
- Any student who misses 50% or more of a school day is considered absent and must be included in the calculation.

Note: Students enrolled in more than one school will be included in the report.


The chart below represents the most recent statewide chronic absenteeism data which shows an increase from 2016-2017 (14.15%) to 2017-2018 (16.86%).




The chart below represents the chronic absenteeism rates for 2016-2017. The chart illustrates lower rates of chronic absenteeism in primary grades ($2^{nd} - 5^{th}$) and begins a steady increase beginning in the 6^{th} grade.
