MDE Annual Summer Data Conference has expanded its scope. The name has changed to Mississippi Education and Technology Innovation Symposium (METIS) along with the expanded scope. The main goal is to provide a wide range of technical sessions, accesses to each MDE Program Office, other State Agencies, and representatives from the Privacy Technical Assistance Center at U.S. Department of Education (USDOE).

METIS will focus on current technical issues, including Ransomware, Data Security, Data Privacy and Best practices for web sites. Particularly, the technical sessions will address system issues, updates and performance issues.
