On April 18, 2012, the Commission on School Accreditation recommended that the State Board of Education establish an Accountability Task Force to review the Graduation/Dropout Component of the Statewide Accountability System based on the analysis of three (3) years of data collection.

On May 18, 2012, the State Board of Education approved the establishment of an Accountability Task Force to study and make recommendations regarding the Graduation/Dropout Component of the Statewide Accountability System.

The nine member Accountability Task Force consisted of one member of State Board of Education, one member of the Commission on School Accreditation and seven practitioners from across the state. The Accountability Task Force met on July 17, 2012, and made recommendations for consideration by the State Board of Education on July 19-20, 2012.
