Background Information:

In 2010, a legislative task force, established to study teacher recruitment, recommended that the Mississippi Department of Education (MDE) review currently approved alternate route teacher preparation programs and make changes regarding subject areas and uniformity.

In 2011, the Mississippi Mathematics Teachers Association presented a proposal to Commission on Teacher and Administrator Education, Certification and Licensure and Development (the Commission) seeking changes to the process for adding mathematics 7-12 to a standard license.

In the fall of 2011, the Commission authorized a subcommittee to review the recommendation and proposal.
