<u>Purpose</u>: The purpose of the Career Academy Implementation Project is to provide quality educational opportunities that will increase the percentage of students graduating from high school, provide career pathways that offer advancement and growth potential, and help students make successful transitions to postsecondary education. Career Academies are smaller learning communities of students, academic teachers, and career and technical education teacher(s) in a multi-year program. The Academy is organized around a common career theme with partnerships of employers, the community, and local colleges that bring resources from outside the high school to improve student motivation and achievement. The Office of Career and Technical Education will award three Career Academy grants.
