Scope of Project: The Mississippi Department of Education has held a statewide contract with Xap, formerly Bridges, since 1993. The contract makes information and planning resources available via the internet for assistance with career exploration, educational opportunities or with seeking employment. A Career Information Delivery System (CIDS) is currently being used in a variety of settings (schools, vocational rehabilitation offices, one-stop career centers, job service offices, and economic development offices) statewide to provide information on hundreds of occupations, thousands of colleges and universities, trade/technical schools, financial aid, skills and interest assessment, career planning, and future outlook and wages to allow individuals to make informed career decisions. In addition to the services listed, Xap is used to create an online Individual Career and Academic Plan (iCAP) for all students grades 8-12. The Mississippi Department of Education will continue to contract with this vendor based on successful evaluations of services provided in previous years.

This contract was entered into through the Mississippi Department of Information Technology Services as contracting agent for the Mississippi Department of Education. Personnel associated with this contract are not former Department employees or related to any Department employees.
