35. Approval of request from The University of Mississippi for a modification to Bachelor of Arts in Education program to offer a supplemental endorsement in Child Development Pre-K as recommended by the Commission on Teacher and Administrator Education, Certification and Licensure and Development

Background Information:

According to the University of Mississippi, there is a growing interest in improving the status of Early Childhood Education in the state of Mississippi. The University believes that improvement can begin by offering a quality endorsement in undergraduate programs.

As a result, the Department of Teacher Education proposes to modify the Bachelor of Arts in Education (B.A.E.) program to include Early Childhood Education (ECE) endorsement. The program will provide students with an extensive knowledge base of early childhood education, including child development, ECE methods, special education in ECE and language, and literacy development.

The Commission on Teacher and Administrator Education, Certification and Licensure and Development approved the request on May 13, 2014.

**Please state your specific request:** The Department of Teacher Education at The University of Mississippi has been offering the Bachelor of Arts in Education (B.A.E.) in Elementary Education with a Special Education endorsement (see Appendix A). The Department of Teacher Education would like to offer another endorsement: The B.A.E. in Elementary Education with an Early Childhood Education endorsement. Undergraduate candidates completing the B.A.E. program will be prepared to be professionals in a variety of roles in the field of early childhood education (see Appendix B for Course descriptions for B.A.E. with Early Childhood Education endorsement).

**State rationale:** There is a growing interest in improving the status of Early Childhood Education in the State of Mississippi. One of the ways to improve Early Childhood Education in Mississippi is to offer quality endorsement in undergraduate programs. In our Early Childhood Education Program we have qualified faculty who have extensive experience in the field and have taught courses at other universities (see Appendix C for the CVs of the ECE faculty). Many prospective students have already expressed their interest for B.A.E. with an Early Childhood Education endorsement. ECE faculty have examined endorsement requirements stated by the Mississippi Department Education and developed an ECE endorsement that will provide students with an extensive knowledge base of early childhood education, including child development, ECE methods, special education in ECE and language and literacy development (see Appendix D for institutions with a similar courses of study in Mississippi)

**NOTE:** Program approval is subject to standard review procedures that involve several entities and, therefore, timelines for final approval by the Office of Teacher and Administrator Preparation (TAP) may vary. After TAP approves the program, if it is a new or modified program or requires licensure changes, it may then be subject to approval by the Licensure Commission on Teacher and Administrator Education, Certification and

### **Course Descriptions for B.A.E. with Early Childhood Education Endorsement**

**EDEC 320: Early Childhood Methods (3 credits):** An introduction to the methodology of early childhood education. Topics include influential theorists in the field and their effect on teaching and learning, best practices in developmental settings and learning climates, designing and implementing early childhood curricula, and the range and quality of early childhood contexts.

**EDEC321 Child Development I (3 Credits):** This course will focus on the areas of development and learning that have relevance for early childhood educators. It will provide an understanding of the development (cognitive, affective, psychomotor, social) that takes place in children, birth to eight years old, and also the ways in which these developments can be affected by a variety of factors. Developmentally appropriate practices that promote development and learning will be stressed.

**EDEC 323 Special Education for Early Childhood Development (3 Credits):** This course is an introduction to early intervention/education for children birth to eight with delays, disabilities or exceptionalities. An inclusive approach is presented with strategies for accommodating students with special needs in regular education settings.

**EDEC 324: Early Language and Literacy (3 Credits):** An exploration of factors that shape the young child's (birth through early school years) early literacy experiences. Topics in the course include: brain development in the first years of life; preparing preschool-aged children for later literacy experiences; play as a process and context for literacy development; and various perspectives of emergent language and literacy, including cognitive, ecological (environmental), and sociocultural viewpoints.
