<u>Scope of Project</u>: GCR will upgrade and enhance the APS system. This web-based program serves as the purchasing vehicle for the entire state. The system processes \$80 - \$90 million in food and supply purchases for public, non-public and other organizations annually.

The contractor will provide the following:

- Upgraded application to utilize new software version to bring the current program up-to-date with industry standards and adding enhanced functions.
- The vendor will be responsible for upgrading the application; migrating the
 existing data into the updated database, providing technical
 documentation; providing training to MDE staff and local organizations and
 provided technical assistance and maintenance for the first year.
- The vendor will also supply maintenance and an annual on-going cost beyond the first year.
