Scope of Project: The purpose of this modification is to increase funds to allow the contractor to continue providing services to the Mississippi Department of Education relative to administering the Online Alternate Assessment in grades 3-8 and high school grade 12. The initial Fiscal Year 2015 contract award covered the cost for up to 3,660 students but this count has increased by 500 to a new total of up to 4,160 users. In addition, the cost is \$10 per student per content area, which includes English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics.
