## Minutes of Mississippi Board of Education Meeting

## March 27, 2023

The members of the Mississippi Board of Education met in a Special-Called Teleconference Board meeting at 4:30 p.m. on Monday, March 27, 2023, for the purpose of discussing personnel matters related to appointments within the MDE. The meeting's public location was in the Conference Room at the LifeShare House on the campus of the Mississippi Schools for the Deaf and the Blind, 1252 Eastover Drive, Jackson Mississippi.
