03.A. <u>Action: Award competitive grants for the K-4 Literacy Support High Dosage</u> Tutoring [Goals 1 and 2 – MBE Strategic Plan]

<u>Background and Purpose</u>: High Dosage Tutoring supports the implementation of the Literacy-Based Promotion Act (LBPA) and the Mississippi High-Dosage Tutoring Playbook that aids in improving literacy outcomes for kindergarten through 2nd grade students through tutoring supports. The intent of the grant is to provide tutoring services implementing K-4 Literacy Support: High Dosage Tutoring through grants issued by the Mississippi Department of Education.

Awarding of the grant for each year shall be contingent upon the successful completion of services, a performance evaluation, and the availability of funds.
