03.B. <u>Action: Award competitive grants for the Mississippi Community Oriented</u> <u>Policing Services in Schools Grant (MCOPS) FY24 (2023-2024) [Goal 2 – MBE</u> Strategic Plan]

<u>Background and Purpose</u>: Mississippi Code Annotated § 37-3-82 established the Mississippi Community Oriented Policing Services in Schools (MCOPS) Grant program for the utilization of School Resource Officers (SRO) within the K-12 education system. The law allocates a minimum of \$10,000 per officer for Districts to pay for the salary and benefits of School Resource Officers. The funding must be matched from local funds on a 50/50 matching basis.

•	Grant Period:	July 27, 2023 - June 30, 2024 (With a liquidation period ending July 12, 2024)
•	Award Amount:	\$ 1,980,000
•	Method of Award:	Request for Proposals
