H. <u>Approval of industry certifications that will calculate in the Acceleration component of the Accountability Model for the 2023-2024 School Year</u>

<u>Background Information</u>: Accountability Business Rule 9.2 states that the Acceleration component refers to the percentage of students taking and passing the assessment associated with accelerated courses which include Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB), Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE), dual credit or SBE-approved industry certification courses.

The Mississippi Perkins V State Plan currently identifies industry certification as the Measure of program Quality for career and technical education programs. There are 40 industry certifications that will be administrated through the Career and Technical Education Statewide Testing Program for 2023-2024 School Year for students who successfully participate in the corresponding program of study. The Office of Career and Technical Education is requesting approval for these 40 industry certifications to count in the calculations for Business Rule 9.2 for the 2023-2024 School Year.

The 40 industry certifications have been researched and vetted to ensure alignment to the state program career and technical education curriculum and the current needs of business and industry. Additionally, the State Workforce investment Board (SWIB) reviews the industry certifications to ensure they meet the needs of business industry and qualify for reimbursement in accordance with Miss. Code Ann. § 37-153-15.
