05.A. <u>Action: Award competitive grants for the State Invested Pre-Kindergarten Program</u> [Goal 3 – MBE Strategic Plan]

Background and Purpose: The Mississippi Legislature, in 2022, appropriated new state funding to provide public schools a grant opportunity to implement pre-K programs. The purpose of these grants is to provide funding to support high-quality pre-Kindergarten programs for four-year-old children in districts that are not part of an Early Learning Collaborative. The new pre-K programs will meet all ten NIEER benchmarks: use of Early Learning Standards, curriculum supports, teacher degree, teacher specialized training, assistant teacher degree, staff professional development, maximum class size, staff-child ratio, screenings and referrals, and a continuous quality improvement system. Partnerships with local child care centers or Head Start grantees are not a condition for receiving these grants but is itemized as a criterion for extra points in the evaluation process.

Scope of Grant:

• Grant Period: September 28, 2023 – June 30, 2026

(With a liquidation period ending July 12, 2026)

Award Amount: \$6,750,000

Method of Award: Request for Application

Funding Source: State funds
