<u>Background and Purpose:</u> Mississippi Code Ann. § 37-3-82 established the MCOPS for the utilization of School Resource Officers (SRO) within the K-12 education system. The law allocates a minimum of \$10,000 per school to pay the salary and benefits of School Resource Officers. The funding must be matched from local funds on a 50/50 matching basis. This item represents a second round of the MCOPS competitive grant process for the 2019-2020 school year.
