The contractor will provide professional development and technical assistance to elementary school and community early learning teachers and administrators on classroom instruction and family engagement for the (second) year of a (two-year) procurement including, but not limited to, the following:

- Supporting the implementation of the Early Childhood Kellogg grant and the expansion of early childhood education efforts throughout Mississippi;
- Providing a non-threatening, open, professional, collaborative mentor relationship while modeling effective early childhood teaching strategies, support and trainings for pre-k and kindergarten teachers and administrators in Head Start centers and childcare centers; and
- Identifying needs, communicating the impact of developmentally appropriate practices and supporting the utilization of the Classroom Assessment Scoring System (CLASS) tool to effectively ensure school success.
