# SCHOOL-BASED ADMINISTRATIVE CLAIMING



A PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE OFFICE OF HEALTHY SCHOOLS WITHIN THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

#### **Program Background**

The Mississippi School-Based Administrative Claiming (SBAC) program is a federally funded program that is endorsed by the Mississippi Department of Education (MDE) and the Division of Medicaid (DOM). The SBAC program is directed to all Medicaid-eligible and potentially eligible students.

SBAC involves certain staff in school districts who, as part of their regular routine job duties, helps students and their families learn about Medicaid, apply for Medicaid benefits, refer students to community medical and mental health providers or collaborate with other school staff or community agencies to better address the health care needs of students.

#### **How the program works**

School districts participate in a random time study moment sampling (RMS) that collects data identifying the percentage of time the SBAC participant spend performing activities that are reimbursable by DOM. In turn, the district can earn funds for rendering services to children for services that are already being rendered by your school staff.

Each quarter, participants are randomly selected to provide details of what they were doing at a specified moment. It is important that the participant complete the needed documentation in a timely manner. When completing the RMS, it does not matter whether the student is Medicaid eligible or not.

#### **SBAC Roles**

There are three separate and vital roles for the program: SBAC Coordinator, business manager, and school district participant. Please note: The business manager cannot also serve as the SBAC Coordinator. Those two roles should be held by two separate individuals.

- **SBAC Coordinator**: will identify district staff to participate in the program, generate and monitor the roster, coordinate and adequately train participants annually, and monitor staff participation in the RMS process.
- **Business Manager**: input all cost data into the SBAC system quarterly, generate and submit completed district invoices, and verify the final invoice approved by MDE.
- **School District Participant**: participate in the SBAC training and complete RMS sample moment (if selected within a quarter) within deadlines.

### **Steps to getting started**

- 1. Sign an interagency agreement.
- 2. Select a person to serve as the SBAC Coordinator.
- 3. Contact MDE for training.
- 4. Choose those employees in the district that will participant in the program.
- 5. Logon and upload roster.

#### **Guidelines for choosing RMS participants**

DOM has approved over **60 job titles** that can be selected to participate in the SBAC program. Staff that is 100% **federally funded** is not eligible to participate.

#### **Examples of Reimbursable Activities**

The following list contains some examples, **but is not limited to**, of the activities that are reimbursable:

- Referring students for necessary medical health, mental health or substance abuse services covered by Medicaid;
- Participating in a meeting/discussion to coordinate or review a student's needs for health related services covered by Medicaid;
- Scheduling or arranging transportation to social, vocational, and/or educational programs and activities;
- Monitoring and evaluating the Medicaid service components of the IEP as appropriate;
- Providing information to other staff on the child's related medical/mental health services and plans;
- Coordinating the delivery of medical/mental health services for a child with special/sever health care needs;
- Developing strategies to assess or increase the capacity of school medical/mental programs; and,
- Providing follow-up contact or ensuring that a child has received the prescribed medical/mental health services.
