

This story kit includes the following items:


Tactile Chess Set for the Blind Functional Children's Tea Set Handkerchief

This story kit includes the following items:


Wind-Up Mouse Russian Nesting Dolls Broom Marble

This story kit includes the following items:


Coconut Shells Braille Alphabet Magnets Music CD with Chicka Chicka Boom Boom Song






Summary: Jennifer is having a bad day, no matter how hard she tries she cannot stop breaking things and making a mess.




Summary: The narrator of this story describes how they made a clay man named Roly Poly.
