Blocks	 Building Block Towers: various kinds of blocks: unit blocks, Kapla blocks, foam blocks, hollow blocks, LEGOs cardboard boxes (small to medium-sized) plastic milk crates flat surfaces for children to build on images of towers and tall buildings from around the world photocopy of tower that Peter built in <i>Peter's Chair</i> clipboards paper pencils, crayons, and/or markers alphabet chart
