Dismiss children by matching the first letter in their name to words in <i>Peter's Chair</i> , ex. "If your name starts with (hold up letter) <i>P</i> for <i>Peter</i> , <i>B</i> for bone, <i>S</i> for sidewalk, etc."	Dismiss children by colors of items in <i>Peter's Chair</i> , ex. "If you are wearing green, like Peter's crocodile, you may line up."	Dismiss children by matching the first letter in their name to words in <i>Oonga Boonga/Crybaby</i> , ex. "If your name starts with <i>T</i> like <i>tears</i> , <i>S</i> like <i>sobs</i> , <i>W</i> like wails, you may go outside."	Use color recognition to transition children. Point to items in Oonga Boonga/Crybaby, ex. "If you are wearing something blue, like the letters in the title, Oonga Boonga, you may line up."
