That leaves four.

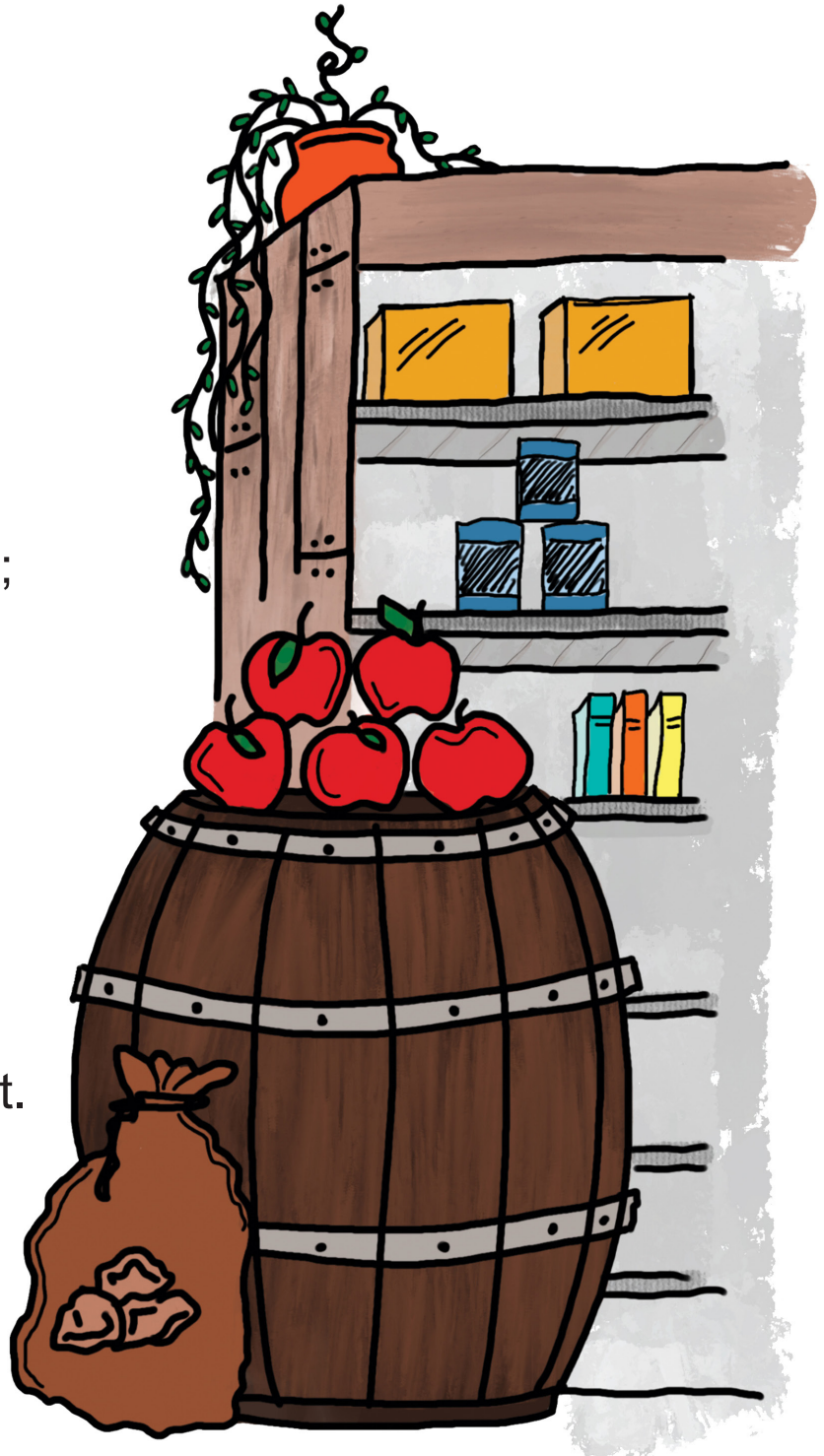
Four juicy apples,

“Missed me!”

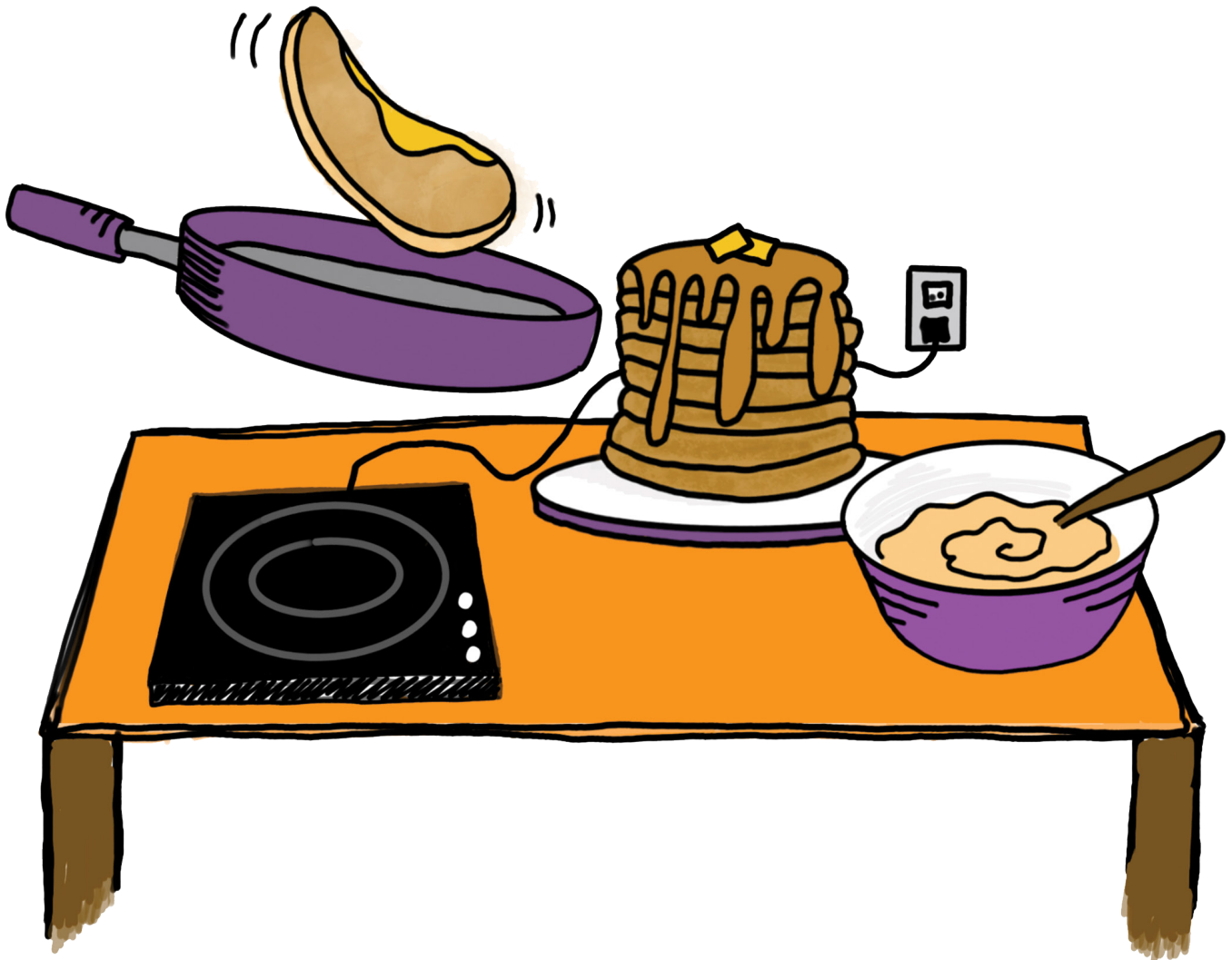




Mix a Pancake
