Intervention Services


The Office of Intervention Services (Pre-K – 12) supports educators and parents who are working with struggling learners, including students who are learning English as a second language. This office is focused on improving academic and behavioral outcomes for students. Staff coordinate the local implementation of policies and procedures and provide professional development on Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) for school-based teams, administrators, staff, and parents.

The office also offers guidance and professional development opportunities for educators and parents related to intervention selection, data-based decision making, evaluation, progress monitoring, dyslexia, gifted learners, and English learners to ensure all students graduate high school ready for college and career.

Three Tier Instructional Model

The Three Tier Instructional Model is a part of State
Board Policy 41.1). This model is designed to meet the needs
of every student and consists of three tiers of instruction:

- Tier 1: Quality classroom instruction based on Mississippi standards.
- Tier 2: Focused supplemental instruction.
- **Tier 3:** Intensive interventions specifically designed to meet the individual needs of students.





The MSIS Intervention Screen's Purpose

- Ensure accurate reporting of student intervention data
- Captures the necessary data to comply with the State Board policies
- Monitor the compliance of timelines and services





Who typically has MSIS Intervention Screen access?

MSIS Intervention Screen and reports are assigned to:

- MSIS District Primary Contact
- Special Education District Role
- TST Role (This is the person responsible for the data that is entered into the Intervention Screen)

Students the TST determine need Tier III support






Students that prepopulate

Criteria for prepopulation on the MSIS Intervention Screen:

- 1. Any student in grades K-3 who has failed 1 year
- 2. Any student in grades 4-12 who has failed 2 years
- Any students who has failed one of the previous 2 years AND has 20 or more days of suspension in the current school year
- 4. Any student who scored at the lowest level on any part of the 3rd or 7th grade statewide accountability assessment
- 5. Any student who was promoted from 3rd to 4th on Good Cause Exemption



Running Intervention Reports






Students that prepopulate

- Conduct a 20-day meeting
- Document the TST decision
- Update the student's status on the intervention screen
- Provide the intervention






Accessing the Intervention Screen






Entering student data





Intervention Tab




Students the TST determine need Tier III support

These students are referred to as Referral Students and will need to be manually entered into MSIS

- Select the module tab
- Go to student intervention entry
- Enter the student's MSIS number
- Click the query icon (magnifying glass) and MSIS will find the student and pull them to the screen



Other general guidance

- The Intervention Screen information will follow a student even if the student moves from district to district or school or to school
- The number of days for suspensions will follow a student from district to district within a school year
