Six Core Principles of Improvement

Identifying and selecting evidence-based practices is a process schools and districts are continuing to strengthen. The implementation of these practices, not just their identification, drives systemic and sustainable change. Implementation science—a process advocated by the Carnegie Foundation—speaks to deploying rapid tests of change to guide the development, revision, and continued refinement of systemic processes. As school/district teams adopt resources and practices and examine implementation results, they should consider the Carnegie Foundation's <u>Six Core Principles of Improvement</u> as a guide.
