#### \*\* Kindergarten Readiness Scribe Accessibility Guidance

(for <u>ALL</u> Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten Students)

1. The Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten student must try to click an answer for the first two questions without assistance. (Clicking answers should have been practiced with the Practice Items.)

2. If the student is unable to select an answer, then a scribe may be used. The TA can serve as the scribe.

- a. Log the student out of the system.
- b. The student must now test individually, with the Proctor directly observing the process to ensure that only the student's chosen answer is input by the scribe.
