The purpose of universal screening in Mississippi:

- assess all students at least three times a year
- provide a critical first look at academic performance and needs
- identify students who may require additional support
- improve educational outcomes, especially in schools that are in significant need

Kindergarten Readiness!

Purpose of Universal Screener - ISIP Istation's Indicators of Progress

- Measure <u>readiness</u> for grade level instruction
- <u>Screen</u> to identify students who are at-risk for struggling with core instruction
- Determine <u>if</u> and <u>degree of</u> <u>intensity</u> of interventions needed
- Saves instructional time!

Istation Logging Out Before ISIP is Complete

Students can complete the ISIP in more than one sitting during the same month.

If the student logs out before the assessment is complete, they will start at the beginning of the **subtest** they left off on when logging back in

If students need to log off before the ISIP is complete, refer to the following steps:

- 1. Click the STOP button in the lower right-hand corner.
- 2. A window will appear saying 'Are you sure you want to exit?'
- 3. Click 'YES' to exit the program and ensure data is immediately saved.

The ISIP Accommodations feature lets educators <u>turn off the Reading assessment question timers</u> if students require extra time.

While your school can use the feature at its own discretion, we recommend it only for students on an IEP that requires extra time on assessments or similar challenges. Please always use caution in interpreting assessment scores for students with ISIP Accommodations turned on. Scores were normed with the timer in mind to help assess automaticity in reading.
