The purpose of universal screening in Mississippi:

- assess all students at least three times a year
- provide a critical first look at academic performance and needs
- identify students who may require additional support
- improve educational outcomes, especially in schools that are in significant need



- Saves instructional time!





Istation's Formative Assessment is computer adaptive to determine the student's **ability level**.






1. **Speaker Button (only applicable on some subtests)** - Students can select this button to hear words read aloud
2. **Begin Subtest Button** - This button will begin to flash once directions have been read and student can begin assessing in that subtest
3. **Stop/Logout Button** - Students select this button to begin logout process

Logging Out Before ISIP is Complete

Students can complete the ISIP in more than one sitting during the same month.

If the student logs out before the assessment is complete, they will start at the beginning of the **subtest** they left off on when logging back in

If students need to log off before the ISIP is complete, refer to the following steps:

1. Click the STOP button in the lower right-hand corner.
2. A window will appear saying 'Are you sure you want to exit?'
3. Click 'YES' to exit the program and ensure data is immediately saved.







