Prior to petitioning the Commission for reinstatement, the Respondent, at his own expense, shall complete a minimum of one (1) seminar or course work related to ethics in education and shall submit proof of his attendance and successful completion of the required course of study. The Commission, in its discretion, may reinstate the Respondent's educator licensure only by a majority vote of all members of the Commission present at the meeting called for that purpose upon the Respondent's satisfactory showing of evidence of rehabilitation. Kenny Goza seconded the motion and the Commission Hearing Subcommittee unanimously voted to suspend for five (5) years, Educator License No.: 267206, held by the Respondent, Arthur Martin.

On a motion by Kenny Goza, seconded by Kelly Fuller, the Commission Hearing Subcommittee unanimously voted to adjourn the hearing at 9:54 a.m.
