


<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Corduroy</i> • <i>Shoes, Shoes, Shoes</i> • clothing/shoes with a variety of fasteners 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • fastener: a device that joins together or fastens • shoelace: a string for fastening shoes • buckle: a clasp used for fastening • button: small knob/disk sewn on a garment used to fasten • Velcro: two strips of material used for fastening • zipper: two rows of metal/plastic teeth used for fastening 	 

Let's Find Out About It:

Preparation: *Set up materials.*

<p>"In <i>Corduroy</i>, Lisa's mother noticed that Corduroy's overall strap was unfastened. Lisa sewed a button on it. How was that helpful?"</p>	<p>Show illustrations.</p> <p>Children respond.</p>
<p>"Many of you are wearing clothes with fasteners. What do you notice?"</p>	<p>Show clothing or point out examples from children's clothing, naming the fasteners and demonstrating how they work.</p> <p>Children respond.</p>
<p>"Shoes can also have fasteners. Why is it helpful to keep your shoes fastened?"</p>	<p>Children respond.</p>
<p>"Let's read this book. The title is <i>Shoes, Shoes, Shoes</i> by Ann Morris."</p>	<p>Read book, pointing out the kind of fastener on each shoe (buckle, shoelace, Velcro, etc.)</p>
