Let's Find Out About It:

Preparation: *Set up materials.*

<p>"In <i>Sometimes I'm Bombaloo</i>, Katie becomes 'Bombaloo' when she gets upset. She says her face is like a monster. She is not really a monster, but the mask helps her to seem like a monster. What do you notice?"</p>	<p>Show illustrations.</p> <p>Children respond.</p>
<p>"Here are masks. What do you notice? What emotion do you think this mask represents?"</p>	<p>Show images or sample masks.</p> <p>Children respond.</p>
<p>"A mask can represent an emotion, like Katie's Bombaloo mask. People can also wear masks to disguise themselves- pretend they are someone/thing else. Why would someone do that?"</p>	<p>Children respond.</p>
<p>"This week in the Creative Arts, you can make a mask that represents an emotion or a mask you can use to disguise yourself."</p>
