

Let's Find Out About It:

Preparation: *Set up materials.*

"In <i>The Seven Chinese Sisters</i> , First Sister got around on a scooter. In <i>Peter's Chair</i> , Peter got around using his feet."	Show illustrations.
"People use different forms of transportation to travel - get around-from place to place."	Read <i>On the Go</i> .
"What do you notice about the ways people get around?"	Show illustrations. Children respond.
"Sometimes people use vehicles to travel . Sometimes people ride animals. Sometimes people walk from one place to another."
