Dramatic Play	<ul> <li>shelves or kitchen furniture</li> <li>empty food containers (cereal boxes, pasta boxes, cans, etc.)</li> <li>pretend food (limit amount - as not to overwhelm)</li> <li>containers</li> <li>shopping baskets</li> <li>paper bags</li> <li>cash register</li> </ul> Day 2 (add): <ul> <li>clipboards</li> <li>paper for grocery lists (see Resource for example)</li> <li>grocery store advertisements</li> </ul>
Science	<ul> <li>Molding Sand:</li> <li>The Little Red Hen (Makes a Pizza)</li> <li>sand</li> <li>spray bottles with water</li> <li>variety of molds (plastic molds, castle molds, cans, gelatin molds, funnels, measuring cups, muffin tins, etc.)</li> <li>plastic spoons</li> <li>shovels or scoops of different sizes</li> <li>gloves/smocks</li> </ul>
Library and Listening	<ul> <li>Researching Recipes, Cookbooks, and Menus:</li> <li>The Little Red Hen (Makes a Pizza)</li> <li>cookbooks (with images of food)</li> <li>sample menus from a variety of restaurants</li> <li>sample recipes</li> <li>iPad, laptop, and/or iPhone</li> <li>recipe cards</li> <li>clipboards with paper</li> <li>writing utensils</li> <li>crayons</li> <li>child-made recipe books</li> <li>recipe card icons and images of cooking utensils (see Resource)</li> </ul>
