## Let's Find Out About It:

Preparation: Set up materials.		
"In Dandelion, Dandelion went to Lou's barbershop. What do you notice?"	Show illustrations. Children respond.	
"Here are images of <i>barbershops</i> - stores where people can get a haircut and a <i>shave.</i> Here are tools barbers use. What do you notice?"	Show images. Children respond.	
"Here are <i>customers</i> waiting for their turn to get their hair cut. What do you notice?"	Show images. Children respond.	
"Boys and men often get their hair cut in a <i>barbershop.</i> Girls and women often get their hair cut and nails polished at a <i>salon.</i> Here are images of <i>salons.</i> "	Show images.	
"How is a <i>salon</i> similar to or different from a <i>barbershop?</i> "	Children respond.
