


Let's Find Out About It:

Preparation: Set up materials.

<p>"In <i>The Little Red Hen (Makes a Pizza)</i>, how did the Hen and her friends cooperate?"</p>	<p>Show illustrations. Children respond.</p>
<p>"In <i>Hooray, a Piñata!</i>, how did Clara, her parents, and her friend Samson prepare - get ready - for her birthday celebration?"</p>	<p>Show illustrations. Children respond.</p>
<p>"What expectations - things you think will happen - should we agree to so that our celebration is successful? How can we be kind, respectful, and helpful?"</p>	<p>Write and draw simple illustrations of children's responses on chart paper for reference. Children respond.</p>
