# Story Sequence Cards (Medium Support)

### **Enduring Understanding(s):**

· Weather affects living things.

## **Essential Question(s):**

• How do you develop the skills, strategies, and capacity to respond appropriately to varied situations?

#### **Materials** Vocabulary **Books** GILBERTO first: at the front Gilberto and the Wind AND THE WIND next: coming immediately One Dark Night or One Dark Night Thunder Cake last: at the end thunder cake story sequence cards sequence: to put in a certain order from Gilberto and the Wind and One Dark **beginning:** the point where Night or Thunder Cake something starts blank books middle: in the center writing utensils end: the final point

#### **Procedure**

**Preparation:** Print, cut out, mount on cardstock, and laminate 2 copies of each set of story sequence cards.

**Procedure:** Children work individually or in pairs to **sequence** images from *One Dark Night* or *Thunder Cake* and *Gilberto and the Wind*. As children **sequence** the cards, encourage them to use the vocabulary 'first,' 'next,' and 'last' or 'beginning,' 'middle,' and 'end' as they retell the story.

Encourage children to draw their own versions of the stories in a blank book or on a storyboard. Scaffold children by reviewing *Gilberto and the Wind* and/or *One Dark Night/Thunder Cake* to recall story **sequence**.
