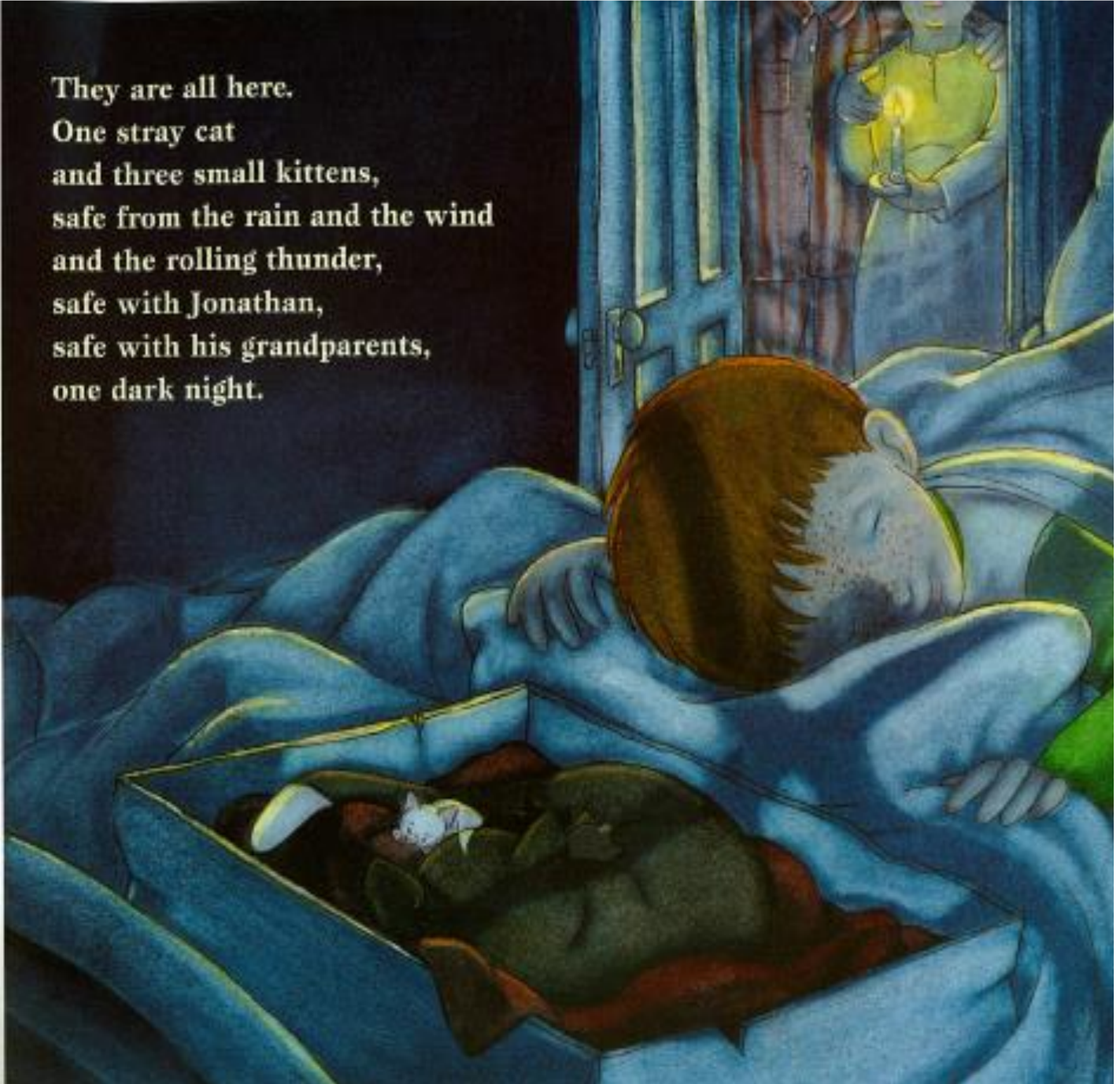



one dark night.



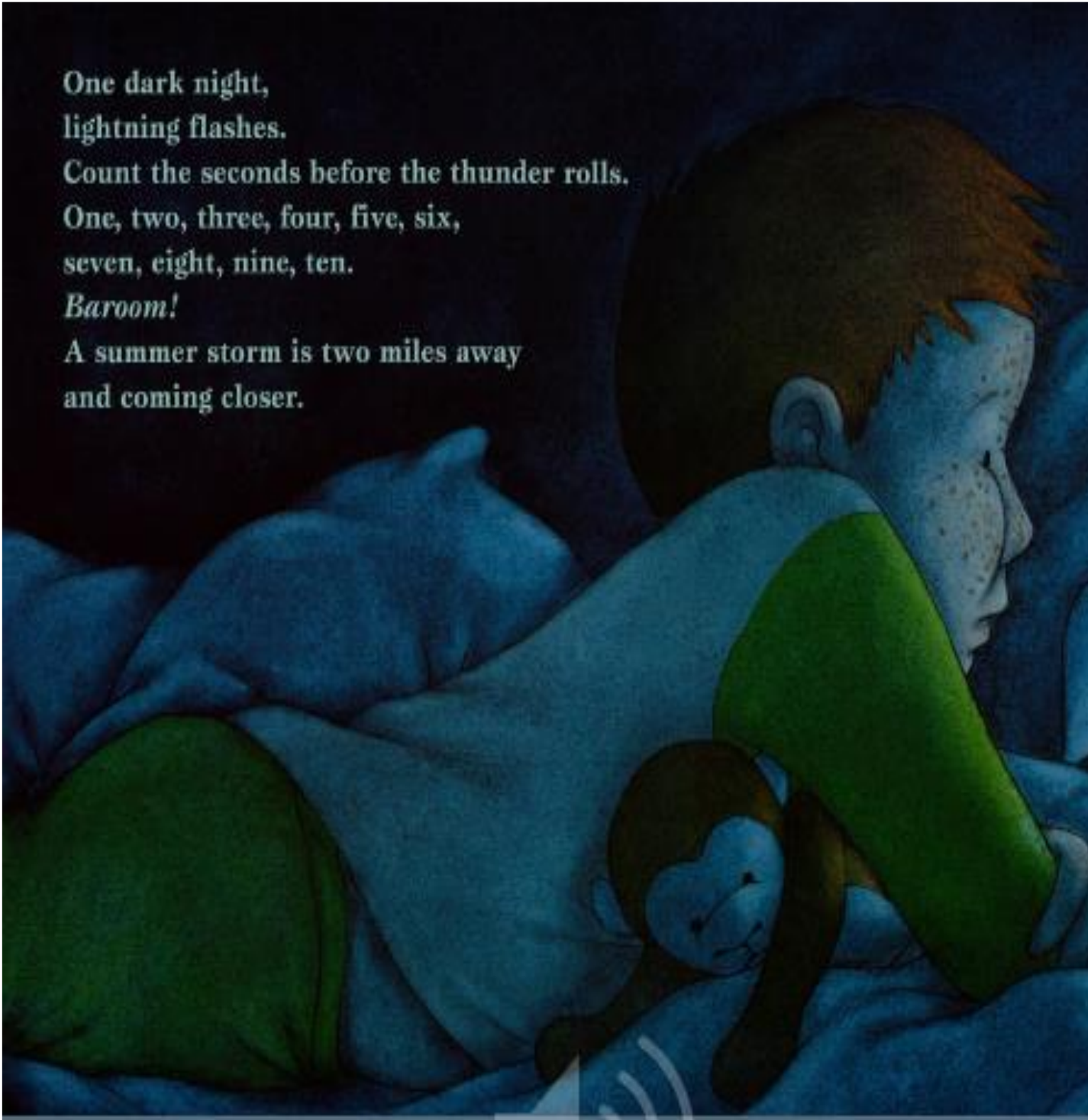






He races downstairs and
