Procedure

Preparation: Make sets of memory cards by cutting out, mounting on poster/tag board, and laminating images of animal babies. Shuffle memory cards and place them face down on the table in a grid. Place more or fewer cards depending on the size of the group and/or the skill level of the children.

Procedure: Show illustrations from *One Dark Night* and/or *Rabbits and Raindrops*. Discuss how the adult animals cared for the baby animals. Show memory cards, naming animal babies. Compare and contrast animal baby names (both foxes and rabbit babies are called *kits*).
