Procedure

Preparation: This is a variation of the Baby Animal Memory Game. Print out, mount on cardstock, and laminate images. Set cards face down in two sections on the table - one section with images of adult animals and the other section with images of baby animals.

Procedure: Show illustrations from *One Dark Night* (or *Thunder Cake*) and *Rabbits and Raindrops*. Show images of adult and baby animals, naming each. Model game. Compare and contrast animals that have similar baby animals' names (a baby rabbit is a *kit*, a baby cat is a *kitten*).
