(Place right hand at waist. Hold left elbow up with hand bent down.)


When I get all steamed up Hear me shout, "Tip me over, and pour me out!"





And the itsy, bitsy spider Went up the spout again.





Mix a pancake, Stir a pancake; Pop it in the pan. Fry the pancake, Toss the pancake; Catch it if you can.





Clap once more. Take a bow. Stamp your foot. Stop right now.


Wave your hand Bend two knees. Sit back down, And look at me.


Five Little Owls in an Old Elm Tree
