Let's Find Out About It:			
Preparation: Set up materials.			
"In Max's Dragon Shirt, Max spilled ice cream on his dragon shirt. What do you notice?"	Show illustrations. Children respond.		
"Max's shirt was stained . You experimented with making and washing stains . What do you notice?"	Show documentation of Washing Stains. Children respond.		
"The stains disappeared or faded - become lighter in color."			
"Washing with soap and water can fade stains. We will experiment with fading using these materials."	Show materials. Model.		
"Instead of washing washcloths, we will hang colored paper in the window. What do you predict will happen to the paper?"	Children respond.
