The Journey of Laundry



Laundry is clothes and linens that need to be cleaned or have just been cleaned. Linens are towels, bed sheets, or tablecloths.



The more you use your clothes and linens the dirtier they get.





When our clothes and LINENS get dirty we put them in a hamper, bag, or laundry basket.

Washing all your laundry at the same time can stain or rip them. That's why it is important to sort laundry by color or fabric.



Your laundry also uses a special kind of soap called laundry detergent. There are a lot of different detergents to help clean all kinds of different clothes.



When you choose the right kind of detergent for your laundry you can begin to wash them in a washing machine and adding water and your detergent.



After being washed your laundry needs to be dried. You dry your laundry by placing it in a dryer or drying machine.



Once your laundry is dried it will need to be folded and put away so that it can be ready to be used again!
