
Initial Consonant Sound/Letter Matching Game

Enduring Understanding(s):

- Shadows and reflections are products of light.

Essential Question(s):

- How does light affect the way things look?

Materials	Vocabulary	Books
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><i>Dreams</i><i>Guess Whose Shadow?</i>images of shadows card game (see Resource)letter cardstrays	<p>letter sound: when a child sees a letter, they are able to say the sound it makes</p> <p>match: the same</p> <p>shadow: the dark shape made when something blocks light</p>	

Procedure

Preparation: *Set up materials*

Procedure: Show cards with shadow images and letters. Model: turning over a shadow image card, say the name of the image aloud, emphasize the initial sound, and match the shadow image to the initial consonant sound. Encourage children to generate other words that have the same initial consonant sound on their card match. Challenge children to match ending consonant sounds.
