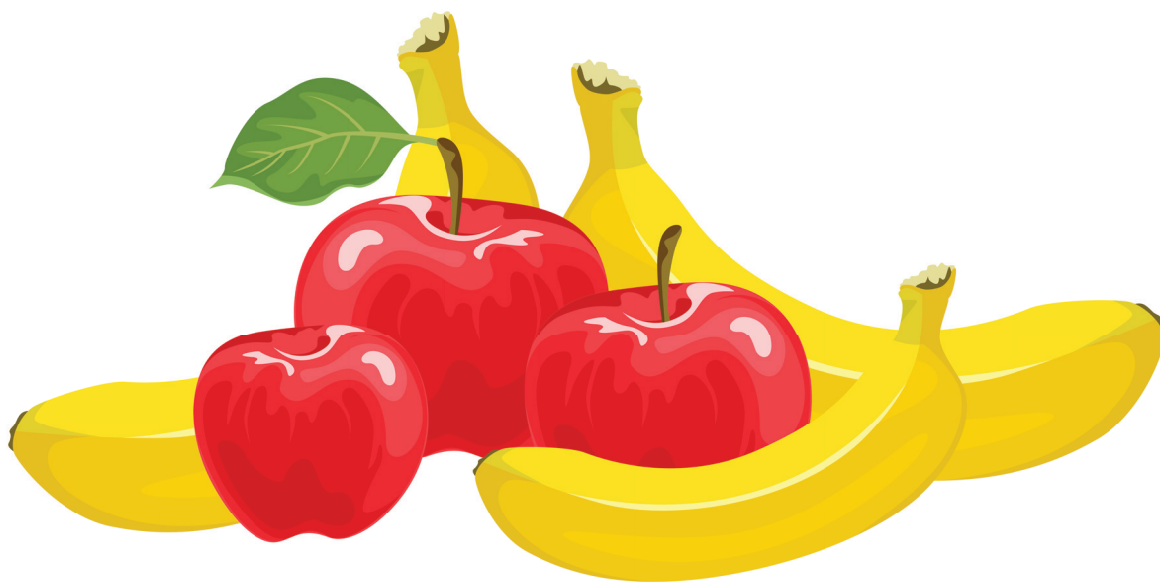

Sing, sing, sing a song...

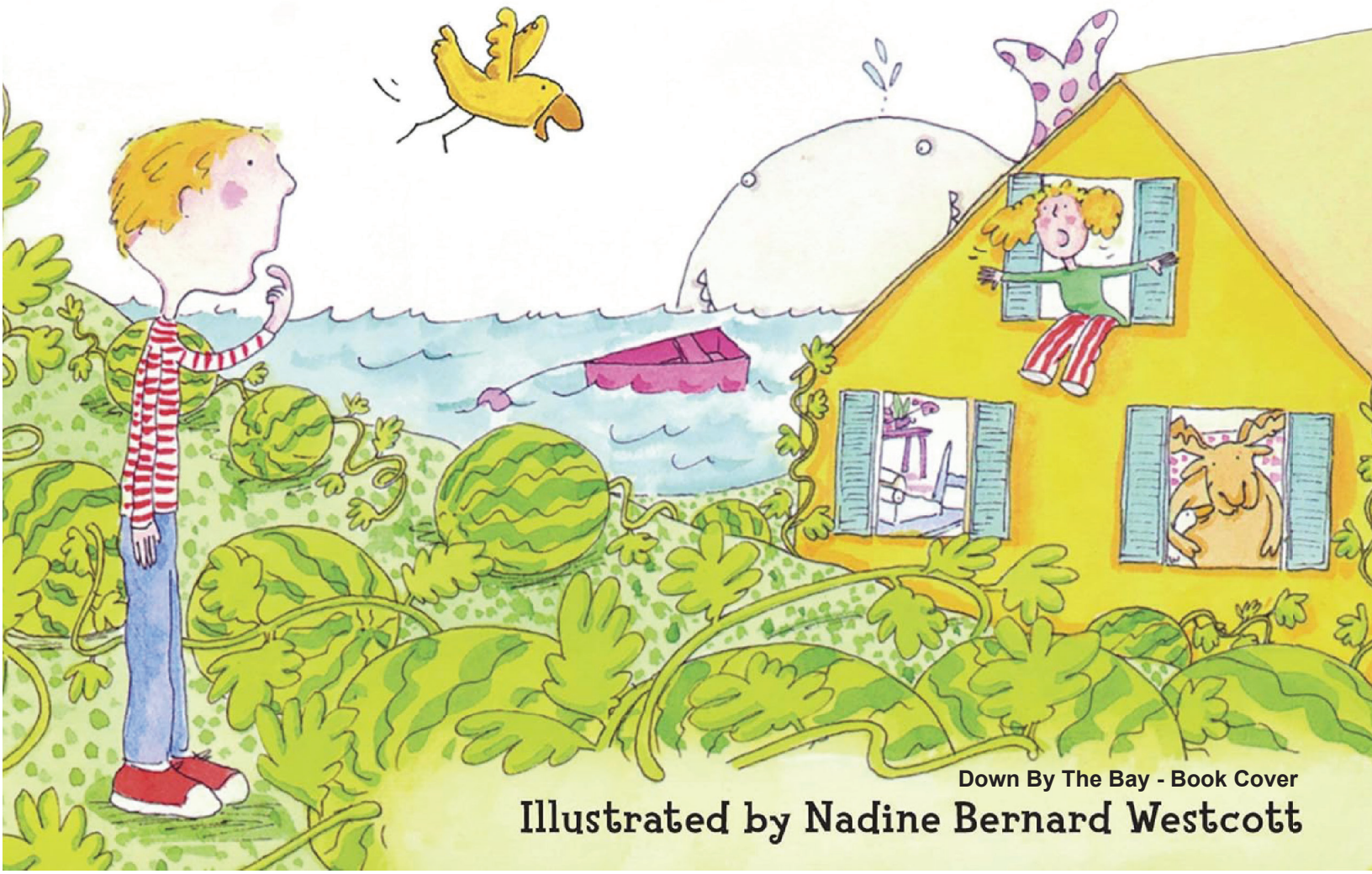

**Old MacDonald had a farm E-I-E-I-O!**

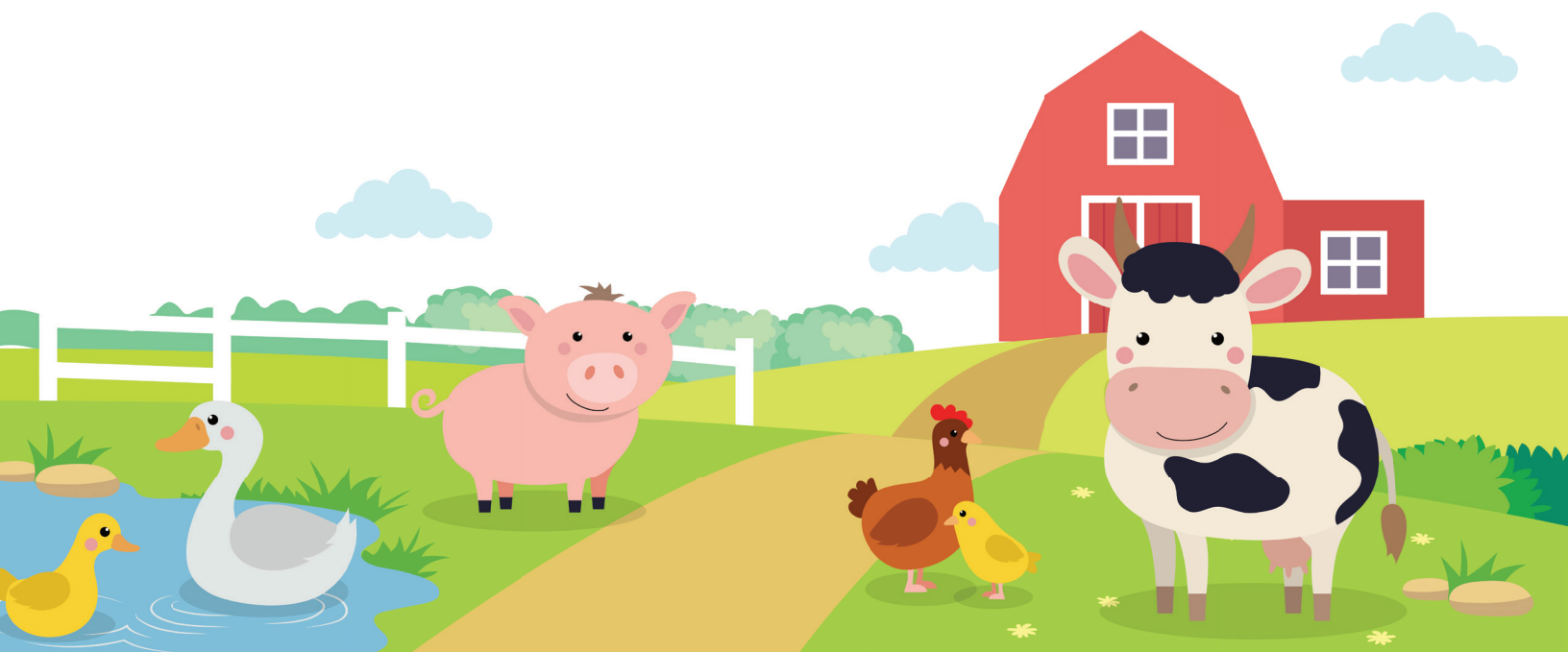

And washed the spider out.**

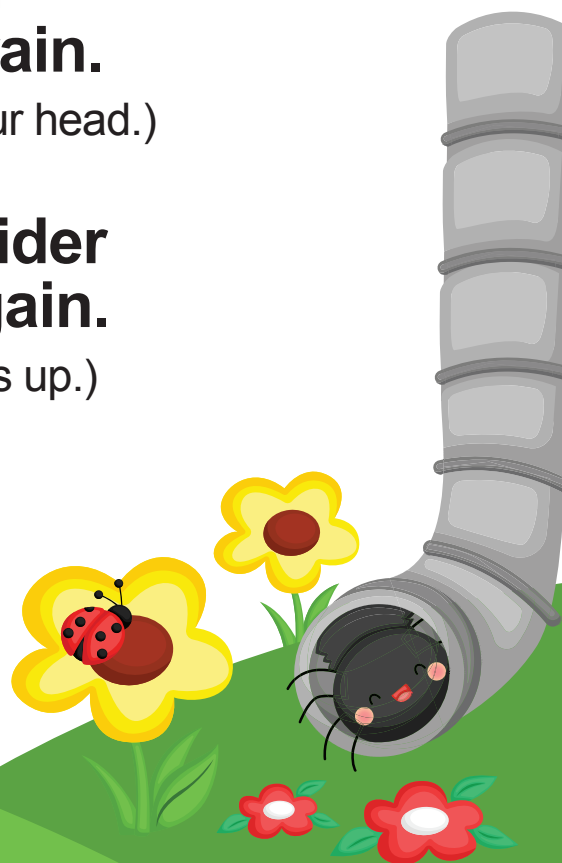
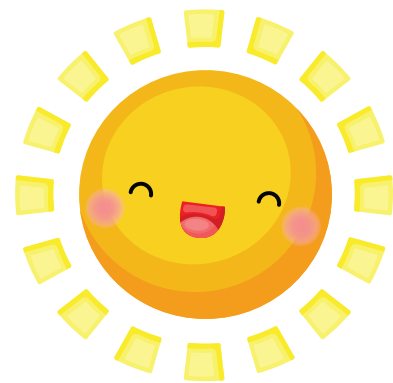
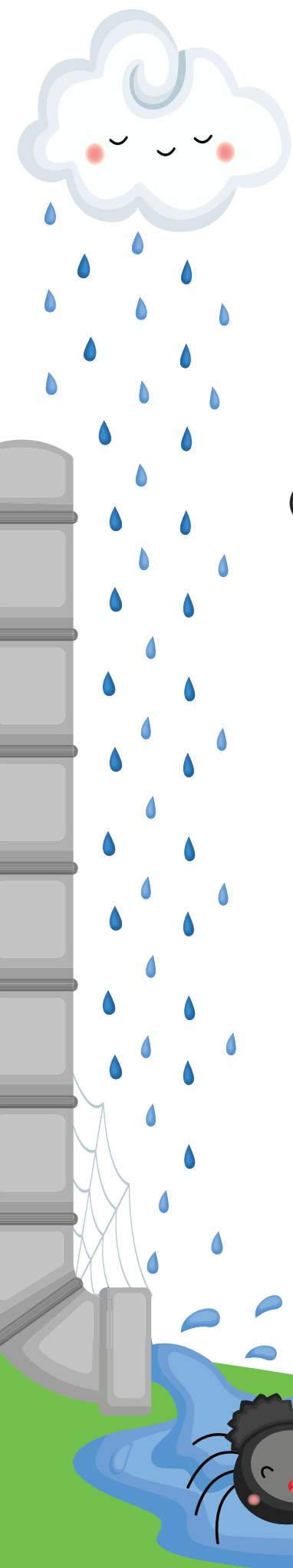
(Push hands out toward sides.)

**A thunderstorm brings!**

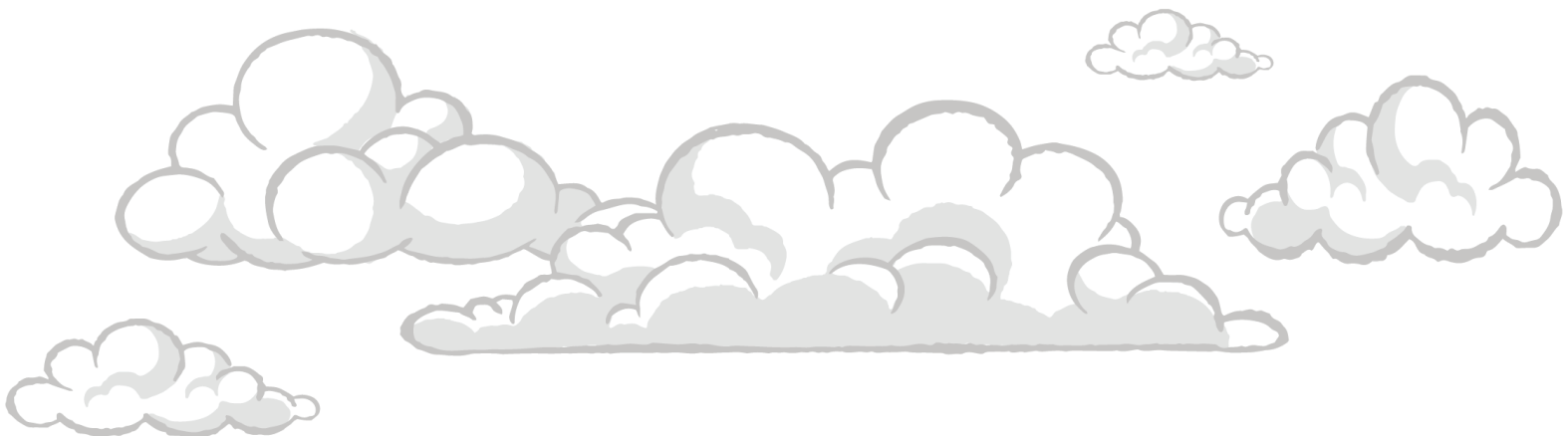




# Cloud

(Show three fingers, then rest head on hands)

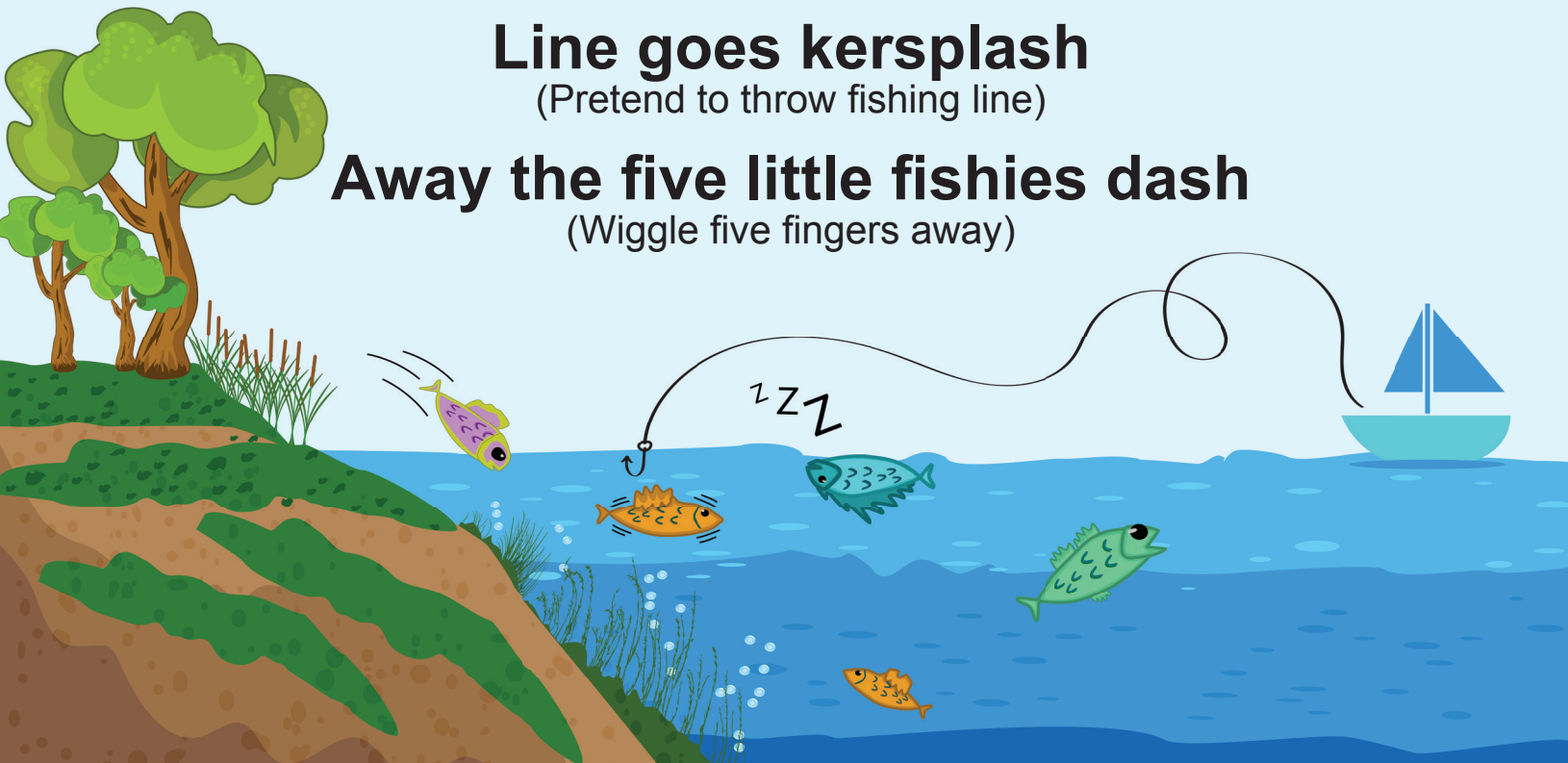
**The fourth one said, “Let’s take a dip.”**

The nicest in town.**

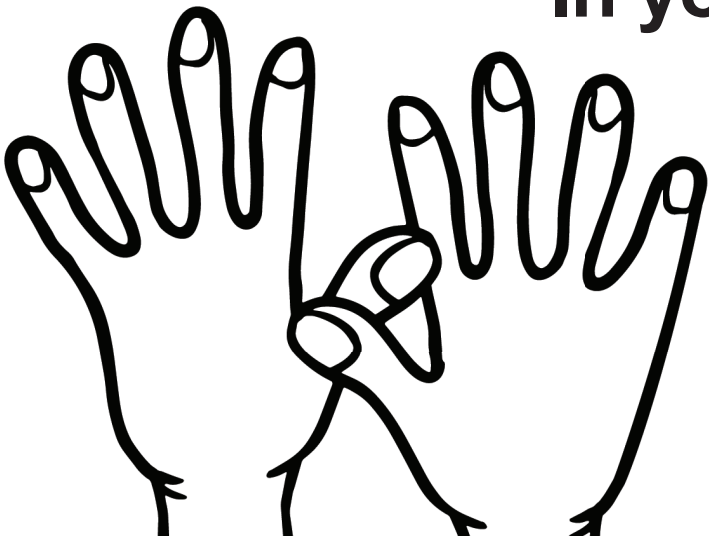
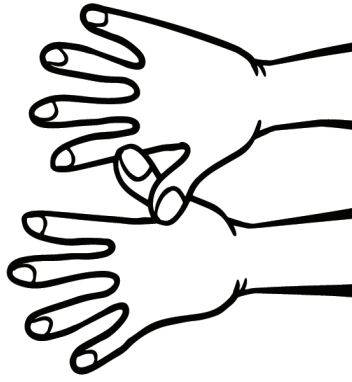


# Hands

And hold them all just so.

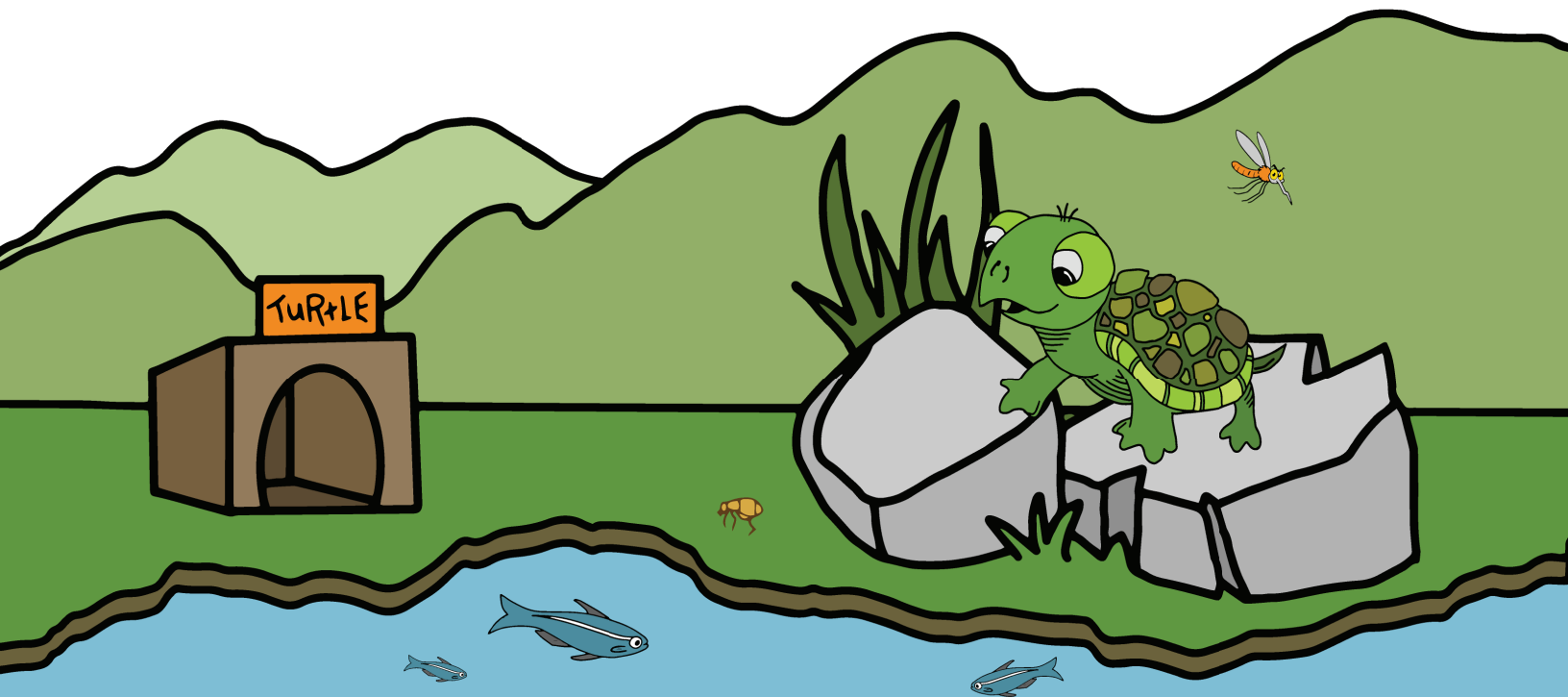


# The Little Turtle
