"Here are images of urban - city - gardens . What do you notice?"	Show images. Children respond.		
"The city garden is a big garden of small gardens planted close together. Each neighbor has a plot - space - that belongs to them. Why is it helpful for city gardeners to plant their crops in a community garden ?"	Show images. Children respond.
