Let's Find Out About It: What Does a Seed Need?

Enduring Understanding(s):

- Living things need food, water, and proper conditions to survive and thrive.
- Living things grow and have life cycles.

Essential Question(s):

- How do living things respond and adapt to their environments?
- What do systems need in order to function successfully?

 The Ugly Vegetables Zinnia's Flower Garden vegetable/flower seed packets images of seeds (see Resource) 	 garden: a section of ground where herbs, fruits, flowers, or vegetables are grown moist: a little wet; damp nourishment: food for life and growth 	 packet: a little envelope to hold something seed: part of a plant that grows into a new plant soil: a mixture of minerals, water, air, and organic matter 	Zinnia's Flower Garden

Let's Find Out About It:

Preparation: Set up materials.				
"In <i>Zinnia's Flower Garden</i> and in <i>The Ugly Vegetables</i> , Zinnia, the girl, and her mother planted gardens . What do you notice?"	Show illustrations. Children respond.			
"Here are packets - little envelopes - of seeds . Which seeds do you think Zinnia/the girl and her mother would plant in their garden ? Why?"	Show packets. Children respond.			
"A seed needs food, water, and warmth to grow."				
"Seeds get nourishment - food - from the soil. How did Zinnia prepare the soil?"	Show illustrations. Children respond.			
"Zinnia aerated - made holes for air - in the soil with a shovel. She used a rake to remove stones."	Show illustrations.			
" Seeds get moist - wet - when it rains. Why did the girl and her mother water the garden with a hose?"	Show illustrations. Children respond.			
"Seeds get warm when light shines on them. What do you notice?"	Show illustrations. Children respond.			
"The gardeners planted the seeds in a sunny place."	Show illustrations.
