Let's Find Out About It:		
Preparation: Set up materials.		
"In <i>Bigger!</i> , the boy matured - grew - from a baby to a preschooler. What do you notice?"	Show illustrations. Children respond.	
"The boy was more capable - he could do more things - as a preschooler than he was as a baby."		
<i>Suggested Options:</i> "Here are illustrations (<u>child</u>) drew. What do you notice?" "(<u>Child's</u>) drawing of progressed - got better - by"	Show documentation/samples of children's work throughout the year. Note the progression of work (writing has become neater/drawings include more details, etc.).	
"Here are images of our class lining up. What do you notice?"	Show images. Children respond.	
"You became capable of many things like by practicing ."
